I wanted to take the time to say thanks again to the March of Dimes. It has been 5+ months since we received the generous donation. Because of this contribution, the Maternal Child Department purchased a television, DVD, cart and car seat videos in both English and Spanish.

The TV/DVDs are used on our unit before each new family is discharged. As a result, more than 800 parents will receive updated information on newborn care and car seat safety. We will also use the TV/DVD in our supervised triage and newborn clinic area. This will allow us to share other health related information with prenatal and newborn families, including the use of folic acid, ways to prevent premature birth, and ideas for healthy lifestyles.
