



## *Billing for Preconception Care*

Most health insurance plans cover all or part of the medical services associated with preconception care and family planning.

- The State Family PACT program provides lower-income women with coverage for many preconception care services and all family planning services. Listed below are examples of the Family PACT procedure codes relevant to preconception care and family planning. Only providers certified by the California Department of Health Services can bill the Family PACT program. Providers with an existing Medi-Cal provider number can call 1-800-257-6900 to receive information on how to become certified for Family PACT.
- Many Medi-Cal program participants are eligible for a broad range of preconception care services and all family planning services. Specifically, they are eligible if their Medi-Cal coverage is "full-scope." For patients with "restricted" coverage, eligibility varies; refer to the Medi-Cal Provider Manual.
- Private insurance plans vary in terms of their coverage of preconception services. You need to call the carrier to verify what services are covered under the patient's plan.
